

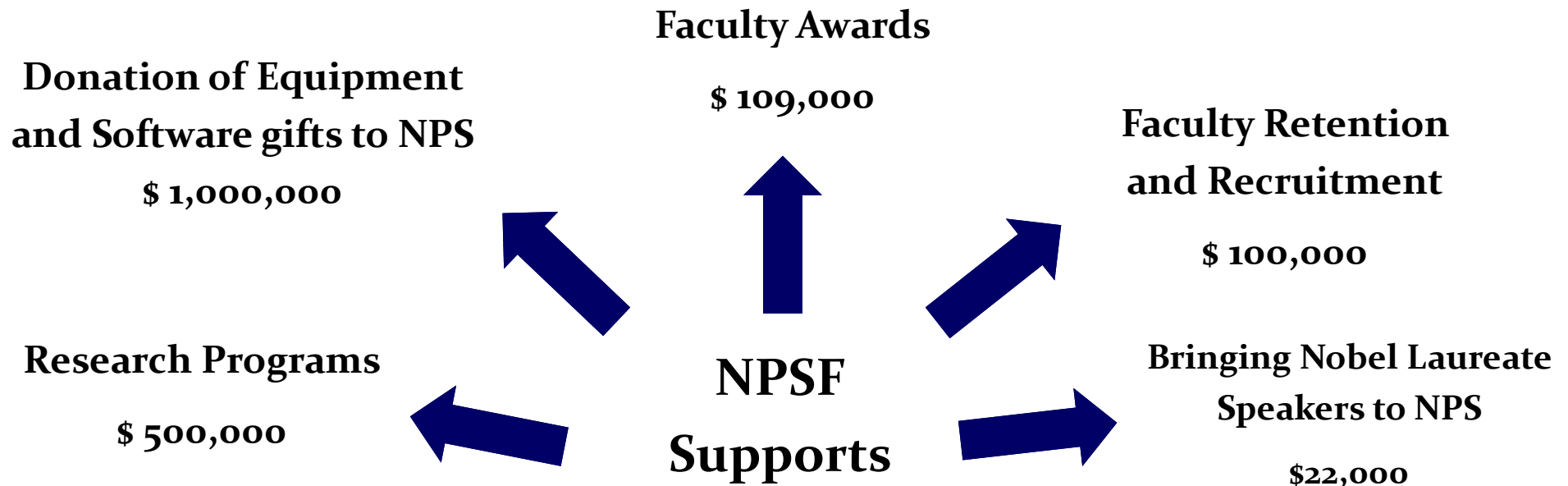

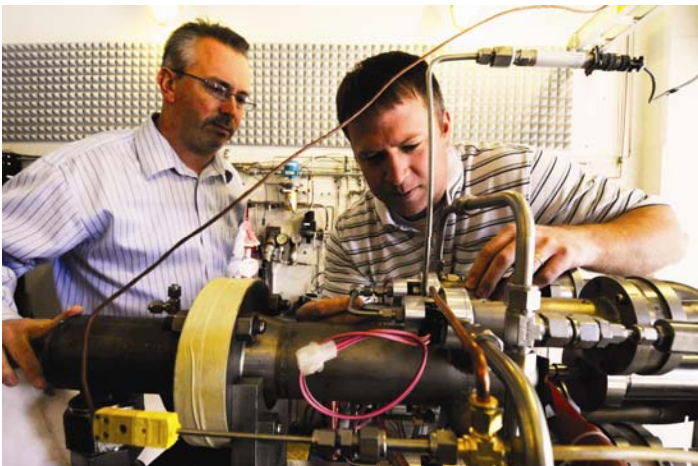

Faculty Awards

Faculty awards funded by the NPS Foundation have totaled \$109,000 over the past five years. Awards that the NPS Foundation sponsors include:

- Menneken Award for Excellence in Scientific Research (\$5,000 annually)
- NPS Foundation Award for Excellence in Scientific Research (\$5,000 annually)
- Schieffelin Award for Excellence in Teaching (\$1,000 annually)
- Hamming Award for Interdisciplinary Achievement (\$2,500 semi-annually)
- Hamming Teaching Excellence Award (\$2,500 annually)
- Williams Outstanding Professor Award (\$500 quarterly)
- Liskin Award for Teaching GSBPP (\$500 quarterly)
- Northrop Grumman SEI Faculty Award (\$500 quarterly)



Faculty Retention and Recruitment

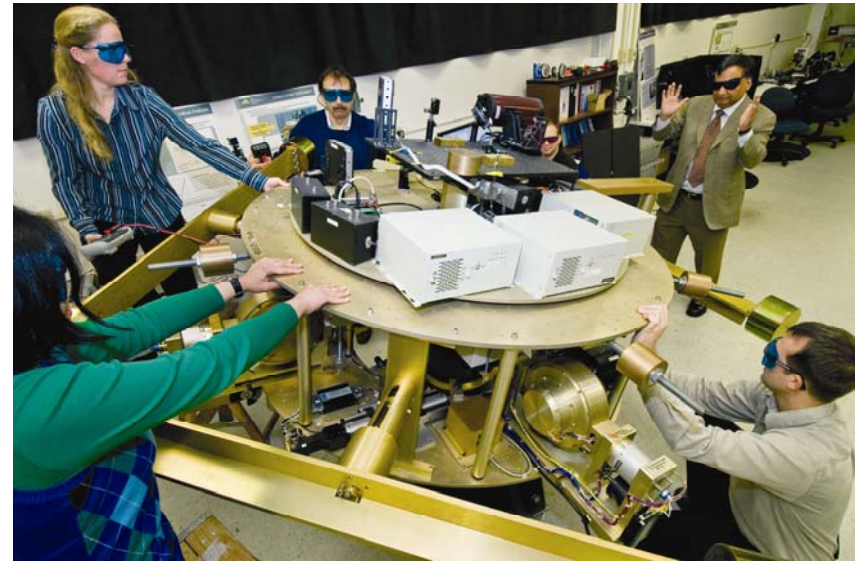

The NPS Foundation has provided program support in many areas at NPS. Among those who have received our support for research are:

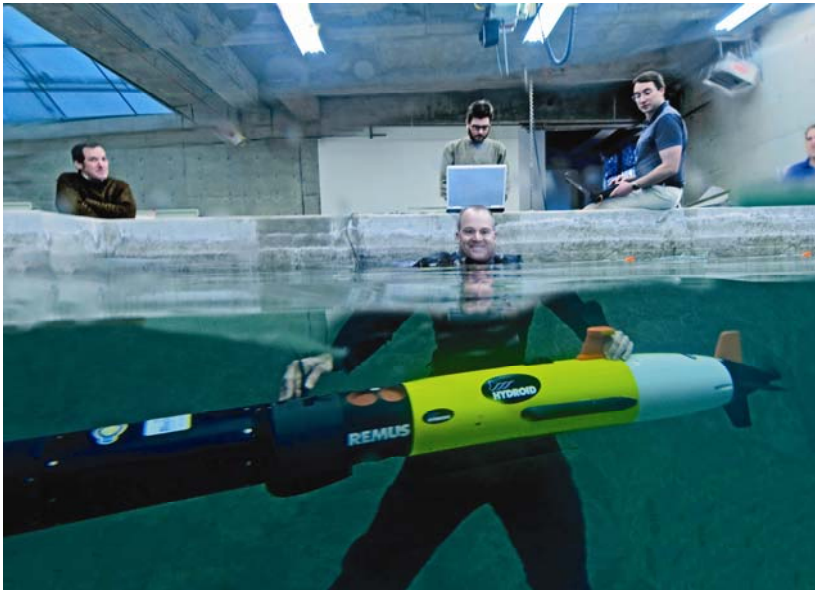

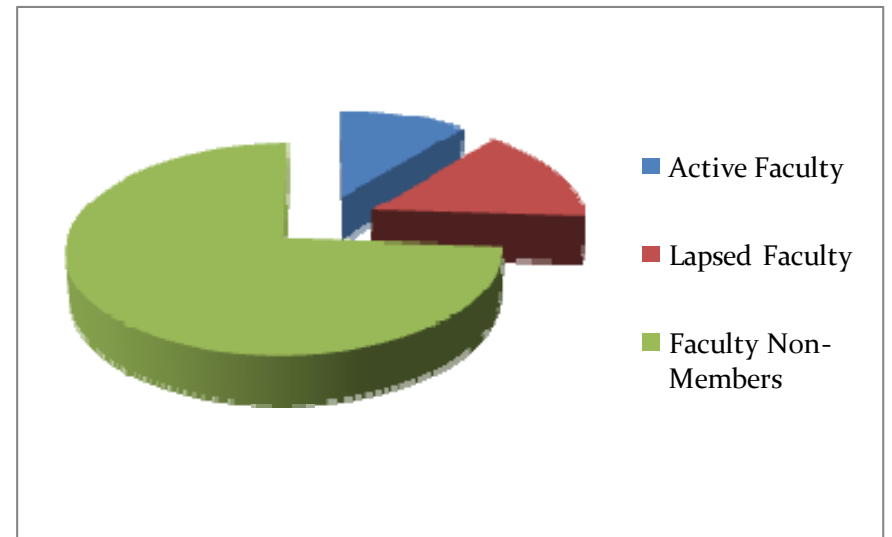

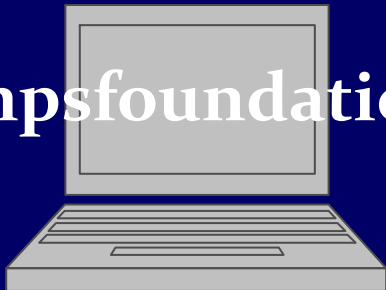


Keeping you informed
